

## GUIDANCE FOR THE USE OF CHILDCARE VOUCHERS TOWARDS SCHOOL FEES

- 1. St Faith's accepts childcare vouchers towards the payment of childcare. The guidelines for accepting childcare vouchers are as follows:
  - a. The tax legislation defines 'care' as; "any form of care or supervised activity that is not provided in the course of a child's compulsory education".
  - b. The care takes place on premises that are covered by the school inspection;
  - c. The care takes place outside of normal school hours, i.e., hours allocated to the provision of compulsory education;
  - d. The charge for the care does not include any charges relating to the child's compulsory education.
- 2. The distinction between the child's compulsory education and other activities is an important one, since the former is not qualifying childcare. Currently education is compulsory from a child's fifth birthday until its sixteenth birthday.
- 3. Applying these principles to typical scenarios at St Faith's, we **are able** to accept childcare vouchers for the following only:
  - a. School fees for pupils up to and including the term they turn 5
  - b. Late Stay
  - c. After school activities on the school premises eg. Kung Fu, Judo, Dance etc.
  - d. Summer holiday activities eg. Multi-activity, Play-shop etc.
