Junior Mathematics Challenge

Following the great success our pupils achieved in the National Junior Mathematics Challenge earlier in the term (67 pupils being awarded a certificate, including 16 gold) the top nine pupils were invited to take part in the next round. That day duly occurred, and on Tuesday, Kuankuan Lin in Year 7, as one of the top 1,200 in the country sat a two hour Maths paper, whilst John Hansen, Isabella Woods and Lex Walker in Year 8, Juliette Brooking, Emily Hill, Daniel Myhill and Harry Long in Year 7 and Emily Young in Year 6 sat the one hour Kangaroo paper which was for the next 7000 pupils, out of over 300,000 who entered.
