You will need

A cardboard box eg. cereal box, cereal bar box,
Glue
A piece of plain paper
Scissors

- 1) Carefully take the cardboard box apart by lifting up each of the flaps and sliding your finger under them.
- 2) Lay the opened box (ie. the net) on the table
- 3) Turn the box inside out ie. patterns and adverts on the inside
- 4) Reassemble the box by gluing the flaps down
- 5) Leave the top of the box open
- 6) Write your name on your box
- 7) Cut the plain paper so that it will fit on one of the faces of your box
- 8) Write your name on the piece of paper
- 9) Place the piece of paper inside the box.
