As mentioned earlier in the term, we had our best ever results in this year's Junior Mathematics Challenge. This is a national competition aimed at the most able Year 8 pupils, with over 250 000 taking part from over 3 700 schools. The top 7% of those are awarded gold and the top 0.5 % are invited to take part in the Olympiad round, with several thousand taking the kangaroo paper.
