Phonic booklet 2 is now completed. Both phonics booklets can be kept at home for revision. Keep practising all the sounds taught, especially the sounds in booklet 2, and make use of the lined pages on the 'homework' sheets to practise writing sounds your child is not yet secure with, if you haven't already done so.

This week our focus has been on the story of 'The Ugly Duckling'. The children enjoyed watching a theatre group acting out the story. We have thought about how it is unkind to leave people out, as well as kind and unkind things to say. We have also sequenced the story and gone for a walk around school to look for signs of bird life.

This week in Maths we have been thinking about weighing and counting objects. To support this learning at home you could join in the RSPB Big Bird Watch.
