Our story focus of 'Owl Babies' has been enjoyed by the children. They have been thinking about differences between night-time and daytime. We have made clay owls and written messages from Mummy to the baby owls.

This week in Maths, we have been counting and ordering numbers to 20. For homework this week, we would like you to make a timeline with your child, of special events that have occurred in their life, for example their birthdays, a birth of a sibling, a special holiday etc. Encourage your child to brainstorm important events and then help set them out in the order they occurred. This will help them learn to use numbers while developing a sense of chronology. Questions you may like to ask include:

- How do you know this event goes here?
- Tell me about your timeline.
- Will you keep that/them for your timeline?
- How could you show me how old you were?
- What do you see? What are you noticing?
- How old were you when this happened?

Next week we are thinking about what we need to grow. We are also looking forward to our visiting illustrator, Guy Parker-Rees, as well as enjoying a Drama workshop AND our book character dressing up day.
