

UK Junior Mathematical Challenge

Yesterday, almost one hundred of our most able students took part in this year's Junior Mathematical Challenge. This entails them sitting a one hour multiple choice paper, including negative marking for errors on some questions. It is aimed principally at Year 8 pupils across the country and is the most popular challenge of its type with over 300 000 students taking part. We had pupils not only from Year 8, but also Years 7 and 6 taking part and the papers have now been dispatched for marking.
