The registration process just requires your name, gender and email address. You will be asked to enter a password for your own individual account. You will then be prompted to enter the Community Password. No other details need to be entered at this stage.

Once you are registered you will then be able to offer a lift or post a lift request enabling you to find other parents who you can liftshare with. The initiative is dependent upon parents firstly registering to use the site so if you are interested in lift sharing please do make sure that you register your details.
