

Speech and Drama Peripatetic Lessons

Miss Tucker is now taking enquiries for children from Year 3 to Year 8, who would like to take up Speech and Drama lessons from September.

Subjects currently offered to pupils to take an exam in are:

Acting, Shakespeare, Mime, Devising Drama, Speaking of Verse and Prose, Reading for Performance and Public Speaking.

Pupils work towards the prestigious London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art Exams (LAMDA) and are awarded a certificate and remark sheet on completion of their exam.

Miss Tucker has a 100% pass rate with over 70% of pupils achieving a Distinction. Pupils also receive coaching in preparation for Drama scholarship interviews and auditions.

Lessons will be organised, wherever possible, for pupils to work in pairs for those in Years 3 to Year 7 and the lessons allow pupils to develop communication and speaking skills, and helps build self-confidence and self-esteem in a fun and relaxed environment.

Please note that in the case of pupils already learning a musical instrument in school, Speech and Drama lessons result in a further encroachment on academic teaching time. For this reason, a pupil's Tutor, in consultation with the Director of Music and Deputy Head Academic, may advise that starting Speech and Drama lessons is delayed.
