

Dr Bike Workshop for Parents

On Friday 21st September St Faith's will be offering parents the opportunity to have their bike serviced as part of a Parents' Dr Bike Workshop. This is a new initiative the school is running based on the success of both the staff and pupil workshops held each term.

The workshop will be held in the Sports Hall Car Park between 9am and 3pm.

During the workshop the Dr Bike mechanic will carry out a basic health check of your bike and treat minor ailments, like adjusting brakes and gears for correct set up, silencing squeaky brakes etc. The mechanic will also be able to diagnose and recommend treatment for more serious problems which cannot be sorted within the workshop. Please note that if any parts are required e.g. new inner tubes etc. these will be chargeable to yourself.

The cost of the health check per bike is £15. If you would like to book your bike in for a service on this day, please complete the jot form below.
