In this year's national Primary Mathematics Challenge, I am delighted to announce that six of our Year 6 pupils have been awarded a gold certificate for their achievements. The Primary Mathematics Challenge is a fun and exciting mathematical challenge aimed at pupils in Year 6. Answering the questions does not depend on mathematical knowledge alone, but on the ability to think things through, be logical and find ways to solve problems. The paper has 25 questions of which 20 are multiple choice. The questions are graded, starting with easy ones and graduating to harder questions. The final five require an answer where no choices are given.
