

This Cookie Policy explains how St Faith's School uses the personal information we collect and how you can limit our use of that personal data.

Cookies

A cookie is a small piece of information that is placed on your computer when you visit certain websites. For more information on how to control, delete and disable cookies, you may wish to visit 'about cookies' (<http://aboutcookies.org/>) which contains comprehensive information on how to manage cookies on a wide variety of browsers. Please note that managing cookies may affect the functionality of the websites you visit.

We use cookies to:

- Keep an anonymous track of your browsing patterns and to build up a profile of how people use the website.
- Make our website work as efficiently as possible. • Most browsers allow you to turn off cookies. To do this look at the "help" menu on your browser. Switching off cookies may restrict your use of the website and/or delay or affect the way in which it operates.

What information do we gather?

We gather information that does not identify you (e.g. a visitor's behaviour patterns when they visit our website). We collect information that does not identify you to evaluate our site and ensure that our site and services run properly.

How do we gather information?

Information is gathered indirectly (e.g. using website technology).

Use of your information

We might use your information to:

- Remember you when you visit our website and track your browsing patterns by using cookies. You can prevent this, see the Cookies section for more detail.
- Ensure materials on the website or in apps are presented in the most effective manner for you and your computer or mobile device.
- Collate and log numeric internet addresses to improve the website and to monitor website usage.
- Assess and understand feedback and identify usage hotspots.
