The Eco Committee are running a recycling project to collect milk bottle lids to raise money for the Arthur Rank Hospice in Cambridge. If you use plastic milk bottles at home we would be really grateful if you could look at the code number, often inside a triangle, to see if it can be recycled – currently we can collect lids with the number 2 or 4 (sometimes written as 02 or 04).



The lids are weighed and payment made to the Arthur Rank Hospice. They are then recycled into garden furniture. If you normally use milk bottles at home and would usually throw the lids away, why not bring them into school and put them into the collection box in pre-prep or outside the staffroom? Our school catering team and the teachers will be joining in, collecting bottle lids in the staffroom and from the kitchens at breakfast time. We hope that as many families as possible will join us in this project to raise money for a very important local charity.
