Join the Jesus College Choristers for a day! A unique opportunity in Cambridge for boys who love singing. Perfect for boys in Year 2 & 3.

On Saturday 11th May there is an opportunity for any boys aged between 6 and 8, interested in singing, to join the Jesus Choristers for an afternoon. Jesus College is one of only three choirs in Cambridge with boy choristers. Currently there are three Year 4 pupils at St Faith's who are choristers in the Chapel Choir. Choristers receive regular singing lessons and tuition in music theory in addition to the regular training received in the weekly services and rehearsals all at no cost to the parents. In addition to the regular routine, the choir tours regularly, to Romania and USA this year and recordings and concerts also form part of the experience. Boys receive a small sum of pocket money each term and the College operates a bursary scheme which is able to contribute towards the cost of instrumental tuition. Boys have sung at Jesus College for over five hundred years in a beautiful setting and to an extremely high standard. There are currently 26 boys from different 13 different schools in the choir. However, there are similar opportunities available to girls at St Catherine's College and Pembroke College.

There will be a rehearsal at 16.00 ready for an Evensong performance at 18.30 with the Chapel Choir. The Director of Music at Jesus College, Mr Richard Pinell, will be pleased to hear from any parents who might be interested in pursuing this unique opportunity for their son. choir@jesus.cam.uk
