Dmitri Mendeleev discovered the Periodic System 150 years ago in 1869. To celebrate this 150th anniversary, the United Nations General Assembly and UNESCO have declared 2019 as "The International Year of the Periodic Table of Chemical Elements."

To celebrate the International Year of the Periodic Table and Science Week here at St Faith's, the Science Department have placed 99 cards showing different chemical elements around the school site. Starting from Monday 11th March your challenge is to find as many of these cards as possible and record the name, state (solid, liquid or gas) and use of each element.
