

# Harvest Festival - Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September

Following the Service, the gifts are to be collected by the Salvation Army and distributed to those in our community who will most benefit.

Cereals eg Weetabix, cornflakes, rice krispies

Tea (80 bags)

Tins of Spaghetti

Pickle
