



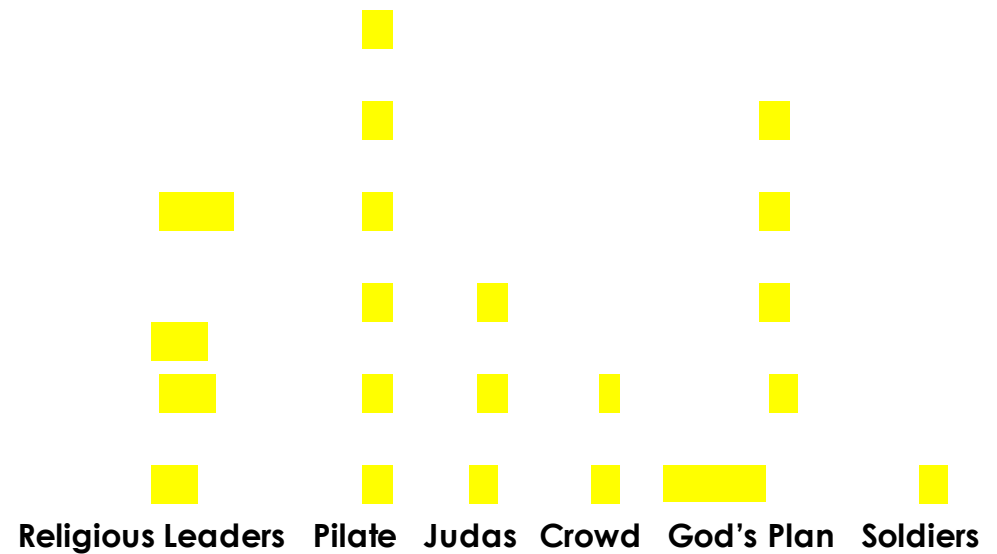

Least Important



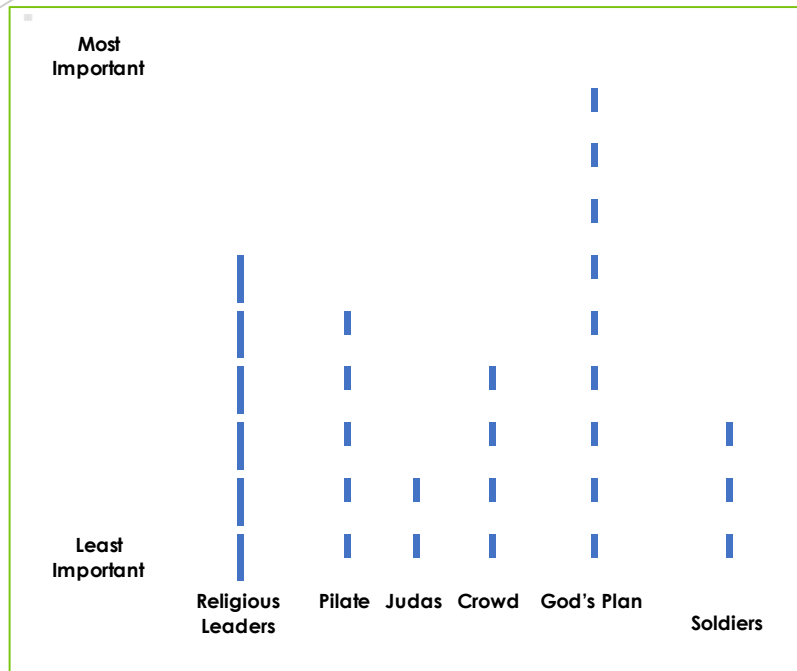
I think that Pilate was the most important cause of Jesus' death.

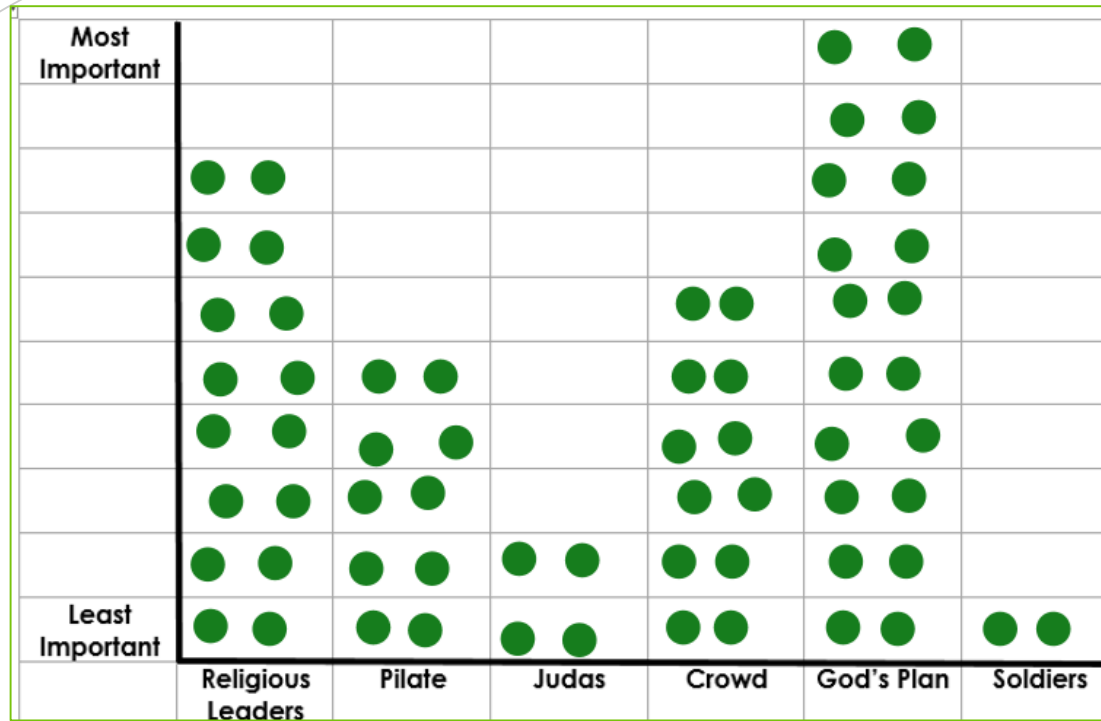
Millie's Viewpoint
