Narnia's new attractions

View point at the white witch's castle

Come and view the sights of Narnia from a place you have never been before! Follow the path East from Mr Tumnus café and grill and this will bring you to the white witch's castle. Once inside this majestic place, you will be able to take stairs to the top. There you will find a fantastic view point where you can take pictures and see for miles around. Open from 10am until 3pm. Entry is £5.00 per adult and £2 per child.

Mr Tumnus's café and grill

Mr Tumnus likes entertaining. Join him for some refreshment at his Café & Grill. Enjoy a pot of tea, or a cold drink, sardines on toast or a sugar topped cake. After 12pm food is served from the grill. Choose from steaks, grilled vegetables or fish, freshly caught from the 'once frozen lake. Open from 9am until 4pm. Just follow the path Northwest from tourist information.

The wardrobe museum

A chance to come and visit the large house where the 'daughters of Eve' and 'sons of Adam' came from. The Wardrobe museum can be entered from the same wardrobe used by the Pevensie family, when they first found Narnia. Tours are run by the professor that looked after them, along with his trusted housekeeper Mrs Macready. You'll be able to see the old artifacts that the professor keeps around the house, also his large book collection. From the balcony, you may want to try some birdwatching or simply stroll around the beautiful grounds. Open from 10am until 5pm. £7.00 per adult and £3 per child. Programmes for guided tours are found at tourist information. The Wardrobe Museum can be found on your left as you leave the Archenland area and enter the heart of Narnia.
