



The average world temperature should be 15°C

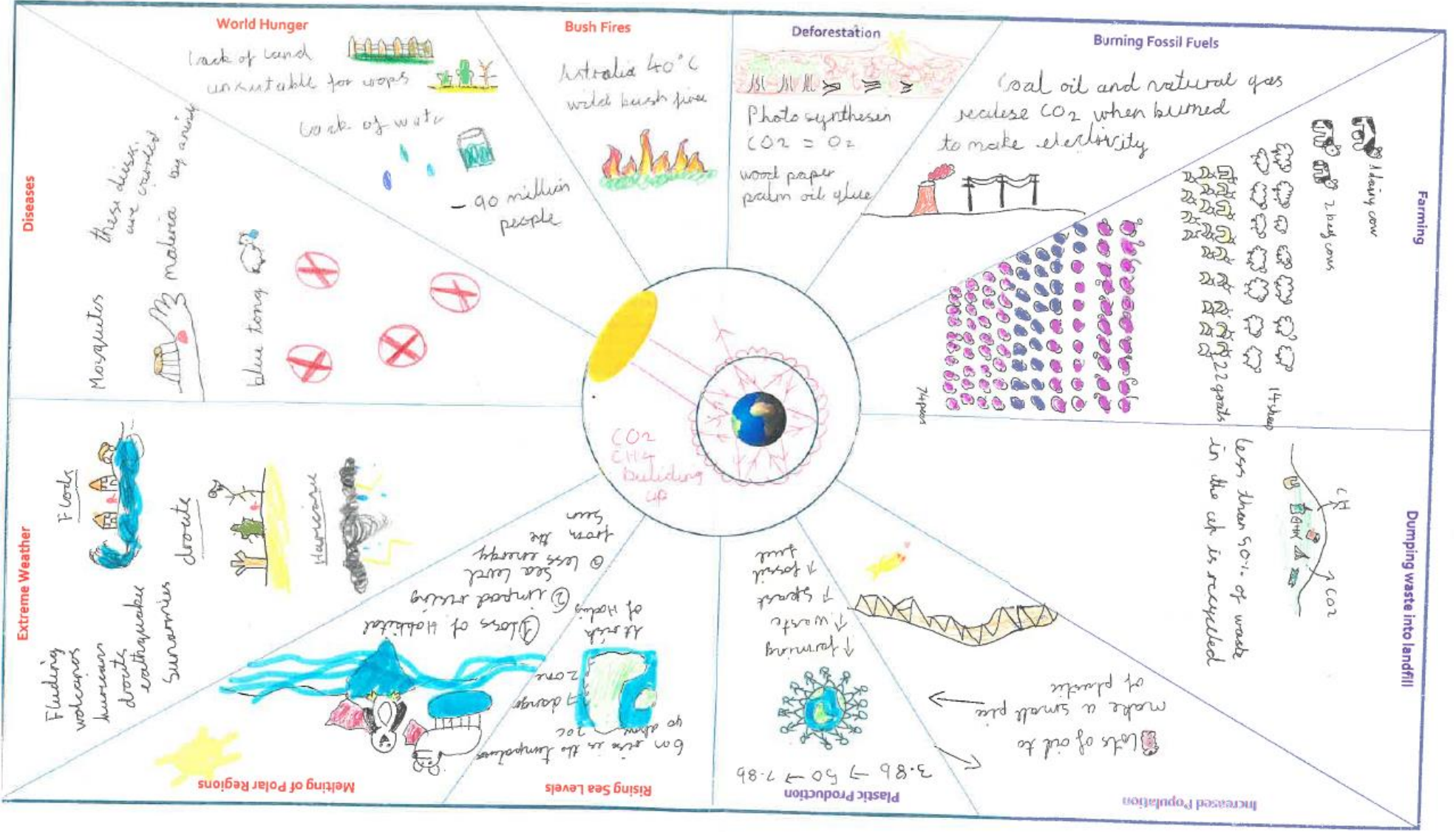
CO<sub>2</sub> = carbon dioxide
