- Which shape would you like to use?
- What can you see in the picture?
- How is this shape similar to/different from ...?
- Is the picture finished?
- Tell me about the shapes you have used?
- How many cubes/cuboids/pyramids/cylinders etc have you used in your picture?
- Why do you want it to go here?
