Two of our former pupils, who are brothers, have both been given the opportunity to attend Universities in America for their chosen sport.

Dominic Clatworthy is heading to McKendree University on a combined Academic/Soccer scholarship, which is likely to be a four-year degree majoring in Business and Finance. Dom was always a superb sportsman here at St Faith's and still holds several 1500m, 800m and 100m records. When he left St Faith's, he moved on to Brentwood and then latterly Millfield School and was part of the England ISFA National Football team alongside being an ISFA National Football Champion in 2020.

Sebastian Clatworthy, his younger brother was also a strong sportsman at St Faith's and still holds some high jump records. He will be attending the prestigious Princeton University, an Ivy League college, where he will be part of their Track and Field programme as a high jumper. Seb is looking to undertake a four-year degree majoring in Economics and Finance. He has a current personal best of 2.04m set in 2020 when he also won the Indoor Welsh U20 and Men's Senior titles aged just 16. For 2021 he is aiming for a 2.10m PB and hopefully winning his first international vest.
