## Chaucer 'Choose-Day'

On **Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> March**, Chaucer House is running **Chaucer 'Choose-Day'** – a home-clothes day for all pupils from Foundation to Year 8, to raise money for the Arthur Rank Hospice. On that day, all pupils (and teachers) are invited to wear their home-clothes in return for making a donation of £2. **Clothing and shoes need to be appropriate for school** (e.g. no crop tops, no onesies, shoulders should be covered and skirts need to be around knee length) and the normal hair, make-up and jewellery rules still apply. Pupils in Foundation and Years 3, 4 and 5 will need to wear something suitable to take part in their Games lesson and swimmers in Year 7 pupils are still required to bring their swimming kit.

Money will be collected by Tutors at morning registration on the day and we hope that as many people as possible will take part to raise money for a very worthwhile charity. Pupils in Years 3 to 8 will learn about the work of the charity in Tutor Time and assemblies this week. Every penny raised will help the hospice to continue its fantastic work and we will also be re-dedicating a leaf on their 'Memory Tree' to Ms Allanson (who many pupils and parents will still fondly remember) in recognition of the support and care she and her family received from the hospice.
