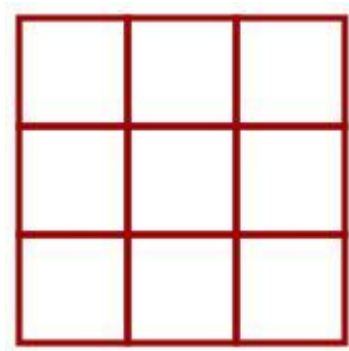


Foundation

This week, we have focused on the story of 'The Runaway Pancake' which many of the children soon realised was very similar to 'The Gingerbread Man'. In Maths this week, we have been thinking about the numbers 9 and 10. For homework this week: You need a partner, a 1-6 dice and a grid like this;



Take turns to throw the dice and draw that number of dots in one of the boxes on the grid. Put *all* of your dots in one of the boxes. You can't split them up and you can't have more than 10 dots in a box. The game is over when all of the boxes have 10 dots in.

Next week we are thinking about the story Stone Soup and our word of the week will be 'surprise'.
