### **Harvest – Suggestions for donations with Best Before date of 2027 (no homemade foods or perishable products, please):**

- Biscuits
- Boxes of Matchmaker chocolates
- Tinned meat eg: minced beef, chicken in sauce, tinned meat pies, corned beef
- Jams and marmalades
- Tins of fruit
- Tinned fish eg: tuna, sardines
- Tins of tomatoes
- Packet of mashed potato
- Instant coffee or hot chocolate
- Medium sized packets of cereal (not a family pack)
- Packet custard or Angel Delight or rice pudding
- Jars of pasta sauce (not pesto)
- Tea (40 teabags)
- Pasta or rice
- Tins of soup
- Tins of baked beans
- Tinned vegetables eg: peas, sweetcorn, carrots
- Tins of chickpeas, lentils, or kidney beans
- Shower gel (unisex)
- Toothpaste
- Toothbrushes
